Beaumont, CA— Memorial Day's long weekend is almost here and the City of Beaumont's event calendar is full as usual! There is no need to travel out when we have so many fun activities going on right here in Beaumont!

On Saturday, May 29th, at 8:00 a.m., runners will hit the streets of Beaumont for the 2nd Annual Breezin' Through Beaumont 5K/10K road race. The race will begin in front of the beautiful Beaumont Civic Center and lead runners up picturesque Palm Avenue with the 5K participants traveling on Oak Valley Parkway and Orange Avenue and the 10K participants traveling through the new Sundance community. Both races will finish at Stewart Park located at 10th Street and Maple Avenue where the Annual Cherry Festival Car and Motorcycle show will take place at 10:00 a.m. Anyone interested in walking or running can register beginning at 6:30 a.m. on the day of the race at the Civic Center, located at 550 E. 6th Street. All race proceeds will be donated to the Beaumont Charitable Foundation which supports charities such as MDA, Beaumont Youth Activity League, Shop with a Hero, and the Adopt-a-Cop program.

Calling all baseball fans! The "Swing Away For MDA" Charity Softball Tournament will take place on Saturday, May 29th, and Sunday, May 30th. Gather up some friends and register as a team or just come out to watch the games and help the City raise \$10,000 for the Muscular Dystrophy Association! Parking will be a \$5 donation toward MDA. The deadline for registering is 10:00 p.m. on Friday, May 28th. The first game will kickoff on Saturday at 11:00 a.m. Coed teams will play throughout the day and men's "Midnight Madness" teams will play from 4:00 p.m. to midnight.
