Police Seek Public's Assistance

Beaumont, CA — On June 15, 2010, at approximately 2:30 p.m., the Beaumont Police Department received a 9-1-1 call reporting an armed robbery that had just occurred at Citibank, located at 777 Beaumont Avenue. A male suspect wearing a surgical mask entered the bank and stood in line waiting for a transaction. Once the suspect reached the bank employee, he opened up a manila envelope containing a hand gun and ordered the employee to put money into the envelope. The gunman left the bank with an undisclosed amount of money and was last seen heading south away from the bank. No one was harmed during the incident.

Officers responded within minutes and began a search of the surrounding area, but were unable to locate the suspect. The gunman was described as a light skin Hispanic male, medium build, and between 20 and 30 years old. He was last seen wearing a dark short sleeve button up shirt, light colored jeans, a dark fisherman style hat, and mirrored sunglasses. The investigation is currently on-going.
